

## **Impulse Case Info Centre Myanmar**

Impulse NGO Network, India is scaling up the Impulse Case Information Centre (ICIC - an online database of trafficked victims) to Myanmar. The project is replicating the ICIC and aims to develop and strengthen an efficient and effective national and regional response and cooperation for anti-human trafficking and also create a collaborative and sustainable network of stakeholders in Myanmar. The project will provide Myanmar an effective approach to address internal human trafficking as well as create a strong collaboration between India and Myanmar on cross-border human trafficking.

The intended outcomes are:

1. Increase in use of ICIC model of reporting on anti-human trafficking cases by the network of anti-human trafficking (AHT) stakeholders in Myanmar
2. Training of law-enforcement authorities in use of the ICIC software to report human trafficking cases to address national and cross-border AHT
3. Potential migrants identified in the mapping exercises been prevented from unsafe migration through awareness raising campaigns and local livelihood initiatives

In the longer-term the project expects to reduce and prevent anti-human trafficking and also provide opportunities for rehabilitation of survivors as well as influence the policy, procedures and practices on case intervention at the national and regional levels.
